Dear customers.

You hörbert has additional electronics that can switch it off after an adjustable time. The automatic shutdown changes the behaviour of your hörbert. We would like to point out two significant changes in the following:

Function and display of the on/off toggle switch:

Without automatic shutdown, hörbert keeps on playing when the toggle switch is in the ON, i.e. when it is tilted to the front of hörbert.

With the automatic shutdown hörbert can be turned off even though its toggle switch is in the ON position. Please explain to your child that, after automatic shutdown, hörbert will not play again until the toggle switch is **switched off and then on** again.

> Behaviour when batteries or rechargeable batteries run out:

The automatic shutdown also includes rechargeable battery protection. Without this additional electronics, it becomes quieter and "croaks" when the batteries or rechargeable batteries run out. This indicates that it is time to change the battery/rechargeable batteries. This will continue until the batteries no longer supply electricity.

The additional electronics interrupts the current song when the batteries or rechargeable batteries are empty and restarts it from the beginning. This behaviour repeats itself again and again in ever shorter intervals as a signal for empty cells. Then please insert 4 new batteries or 4 full rechargeable batteries.

Settings of the automatic shutdown

Setting at delivery

With the automatic shutdown, the playing time can be set in six stages. We deliver the additional electronics with the time setting "infinite".

In this setting, switch no. 6 is in position ON (push down). In this position hörbert will **not** be switched off automatically.



Further settings

To select the desired playing time, set one of the switches 1 to 6 according to the following table. If the switch is pressed down, the corresponding playing time is activated.



Notes on the settings of the playing time:

- a) The setting of the playing time is only valid after the next power-up, you cannot shorten or extend the time during playback.
 - Please switch off your hörbert first (toggle switch to position OFF), in order to set the playing time to avoid an undefined state.
- b) If several of the switches 1-5 are activated simultaneously, the playing time is undefined and hörbert switches off after an indefinite period of time.

Protection settings for rechargeable batteries



For optimum protection of your rechargeable or nonrechargeable batteries, you can adjust the protective circuitry: rechargeable batteries must be prevented from deepdischarging, batteries can be drained more heavily, an early battery leakage can sometimes be postponed.

Do you use rechargeable batteries? (Recommended!) Then **set switch 8 to ON** (as shown in the picture on the left)

Do you use hörbert with alkaline batteries? Then set switch 8 to OFF.

Note: Please remove empty batteries or rechargeable batteries from the device immediately. If your hörbert is not to be used for a longer period of time (e. g. several days at a time), you should always remove the batteries or rechargeable batteries to prevent damage to your hörbert.
